



ACT and SAT Test Requirements

If you are a freshman or transfer applicant who has completed less than 24 hours of college coursework, you must take the ACT (American College Test) and have your scores sent to UNO (college code 1591). National ACT tests are administered in October, December, February, April and June at regular ACT test centers. The SAT I (Scholastic Aptitude Test) (college code 6379) may be used in place of the ACT. The test dates for SAT I are in October, November, December, January, March, May and June at regular SAT test centers.

Additional UNO Requirements

Official test scores, sent directly from the testing center to the University of New Orleans, are required for admission. If you have previously turned in “unofficial” test scores you must follow-up with official scores. Please contact ACT or SAT to have your scores sent to UNO.
